After high school, he entered Holy Trinity Seminary and completed undergraduate studies at the University of Dallas followed by graduate studies at St. Mary's Seminary in Houston and the Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C. He was ordained a priest on June 8, 2013.

Before ordination as a priest, he served as an officer in the Navy Reserve. Some of his past assignments include: Naval Station Newport, RI, Naval Air Station Corpus Christi, the VA Medical Center in Houston and St. Mary's Catholic Center at Texas A&M University. Fr. Barry most recently served at San José parish in Austin and he will join our community effective July 18.

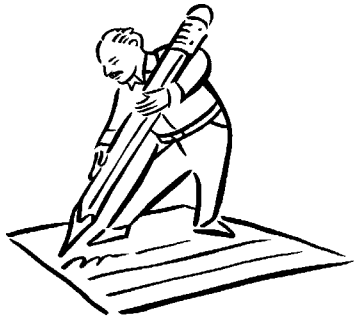

FACT OF FAITH: APOSTLES AND DISCIPLES

Apostle is the title traditionally given to the twelve men specially chosen by Jesus to preach the Gospel and to whom he entrusted responsibility for guiding the early Church. The names of the Twelve are Peter, Andrew, James, John, Thomas, James, Philip, Bartholomew (or Nathaniel), Matthew, Simon, Jude (or Thaddeus), and Matthias (who replaced Judas Iscariot after Judas betrayed Jesus and then took his own life). St. Paul, though not one of the Twelve, was also called later by the Lord to be an Apostle.



Disciple is the name given in the New Testament to all those men and women who followed Jesus and were taught by him while he was alive, and who, following Jesus' Death, Resurrection, and Ascension, formed the Church with the Apostles and helped spread the gospel message. Contemporary members of the Church, as followers of Jesus, can also be referred to as disciples.
